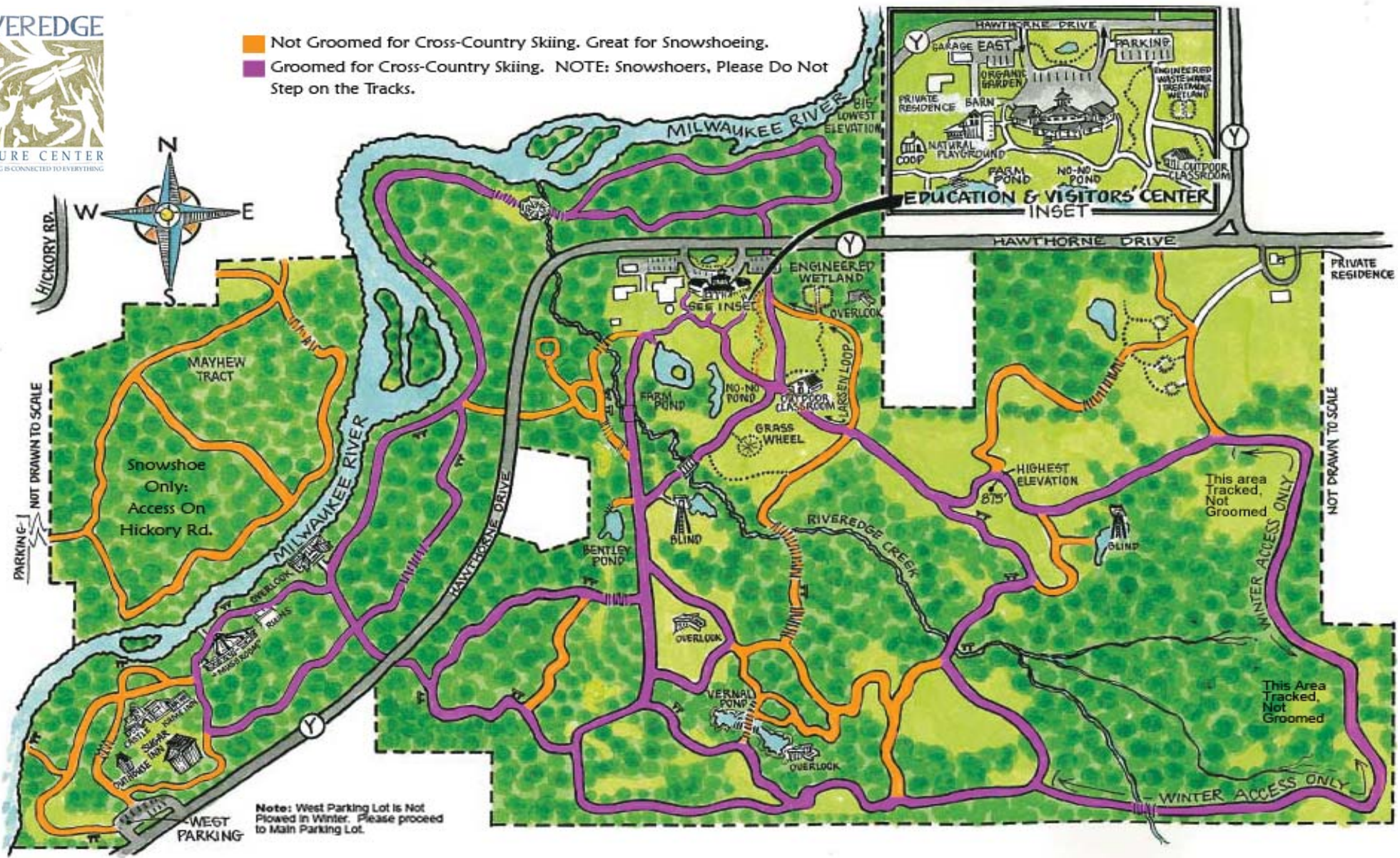


■ Not Groomed for Cross-Country Skiing. Great for Snowshoeing.

Riveredge Nature Center has over 10 miles of trails, 6 of which are groomed and tracked for cross-country skiing. Please see the reverse side for trail fees and Center information, or visit us online at www.riveredgenaturecenter.org. Ski conditions are available online, or feel free to call 800-287-8098.

When enjoying Riveredge, please remember these few simple rules:

- Hiking & Snowshoeing are permitted on ski trails but not on top of the ski tracks.
- Non-members pay a nominal trail fee which supports trail maintenance.
- No dogs or other pets are allowed, other than guide dogs.
- Specially designated snowshoe trails are also located on RNC property across the river (Access and parking on Hickory Road).
- Refrain from smoking when in buildings and on grounds.
- Riveredge is not responsible for skiers or hikers who attempt to cross the Milwaukee River.

Holiday Snowshoe Hike: Family Program

Friday, December 27, 1-3pm

Saturday, January 18, 7-8:30pm

Imagine snowshoeing under the clear, crisp winter night sky with the moonlight reflecting off the snow. Enjoy the beauty of a nighttime snowshoe hike. Discover the creatures active after dark and explore the night sky. All ages will enjoy this adventure. Riveredge will provide the snowshoes (or use your own). Dress for the weather and wear insulated boots. If there is not enough snow for snowshoeing, we will still hike. Hot drinks will be served afterward. Space is limited; please call to reserve your spot.

All non-member trail users (hikers, skiers and snowshoers) should purchase a trail pass at the visitor center or by using our pay envelopes located at the front door of the visitor center and at trailheads. The passes can be returned within one week for a rebate of up to \$12 on the \$40 membership price. Snowshoes Available for Rent:

We have a limited number of snowshoes, so all rentals are on a first come, first serve basis. Snowshoes must stay on Riveredge property. Reservations made in advance must include a credit card number. You will be charged for the rental unless we receive your cancellation within 24 hours. Snowshoes must be returned by 4:45pm on weekdays and 3:45pm on Saturdays and Sundays. All snowshoes not returned on time will be charged a replacement fee. Trails are open daily from dawn to dusk.

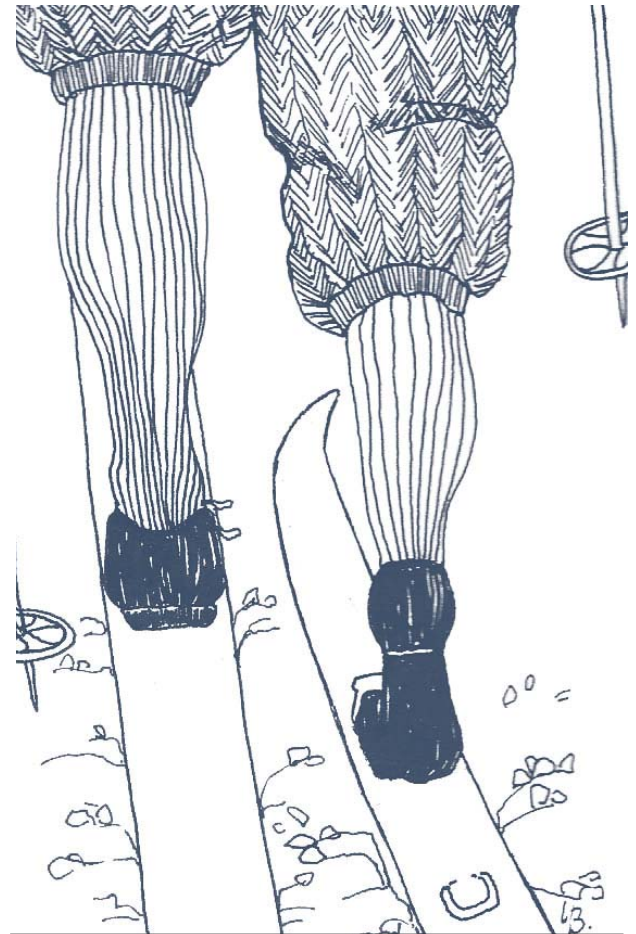
