In 2018, we celebrated 50 years of dedication, teamwork, and partnerships focused on the restoration and preservation of a beautiful piece of "Wild Wisconsin" along the Milwaukee River and the launch of the first independent nature center in southeastern Wisconsin.

Throughout this time, Riveredge Nature Center has grown from 72 to 379 acres. Educational programs began with the first class of Teacher Naturalists (the volunteer education team) taught by Andy Larsen in 1969 and have grown to over 47,000 youth and adults learning through Riveredge efforts last year alone. The founders were not afraid of dreaming big, and there are a lot of big dreams today at Riveredge—dreams positioned to launch the vision and mission forward for the next 50 years.

The common thread connecting the past, present, and future work is the dedication of individuals resulting in the realization of a collective vision. Individuals, like you, who continue to generously offer time, talent, and treasure are making the natural world a bit healthier and brighter. These restored acres of forests, wetlands, and prairies have touched the lives of over 1,000,000 children and adults. 





WHEN THE WHITEFISH BAY GARDEN CLUB FOUNDED RIVEREDGE 50 YEARS AGO,

their hope was that the land would serve as a living classroom for students of all ages to discover the natural world and find their own place within it. While the principles have remained the same, Riveredge programs are continually evolving to meet new challenges and opportunities in the community.

Recent, innovative partnerships with local school districts, including the Scientist in Residence (SIR) program and a nature-based, 4-year-old kindergarten (4K) partnership with the West Bend School District and Kettle Moraine YMCA, represent the ability for Riveredge to discover meaningful ways to partner with our local schools.

Beginning in the West Bend School District in 2015 and the Cedarburg School District in 2016, the SIR program has had incredible success over the last two years, including interactions with 18,919 students and 765 teachers from 2016 to 2018. Evaluation reports suggest that the program's goal, which is to help transform the culture of learning within our region to incorporate outdoor learning on a regular basis, is beginning to be realized. The program will continue in West Bend through 2019-20 and Cedarburg through 2020-21.

As only the second such community-based program in the state, nature-based 4K students are immersed in the natural world and have a classroom that extends far beyond four walls, with a specific requirement that 70% of instructional time be nature-based. In the 2017-18 school year, 40 4K students spent 130 school days learning outdoors. The success and demand for this type of public school model has led to beginning stages of a nature-based elementary school at Riveredge.

Community RIVERS PROJECT

In 2017, Riveredge launched the Community Rivers Program (CRP) with the village of Newburg as a way to engage the communities of the upper Milwaukee River watershed in the health of their river. In 2017-18, the program received a boost through a federal grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Sciences and was selected as one of four projects to receive technical assistance by the EPA's "Building Blocks Technical Assistance Program."

In the EPA's final report, they eloquently describe the connection between the health of our watersheds and community engagement efforts at Riveredge:

66 THE RIVEREDGE NATURE CENTER RECOGNIZES THE IMPORTANCE OF CONNECTING THE REGION'S RURAL AND SUBURBAN COMMUNITIES, THROUGH THEIR SHARED INTEREST IN A HEALTHY MILWAUKEE RIVER BASIN, TO LARGER REGIONAL EFFORTS TO IMPROVE WATER QUALITY.

As a result of additional funding, CRP expanded its reach to the villages of Grafton and Saukville in 2018.









PROGRAM MODEL

In each CRP Healthy River Community, we're taking a three-pronged approach to transforming the community's relationship with the Milwaukee River.

I INSPIRE

Help people develop a passion for and connection to the Milwaukee River.

2 INFORM

Enable best practices in land/water use by providing quality access to educational programming and landscape consultations.

3 ENGAGE

Actively engage residents in making their river healthier through activities like river clean-ups, water monitoring, native landscaping, and stormwater drain stenciling.



While the program is still young, CRP has achieved great / impacts in the region. Over two years, CRP has engaged with 1,232 residents from Newburg, Saukville, and Grafton, with 72% occurring between May AND September 2018. As the result of increased capacity and momentum, CRP saw a 162% increase in participant engagement from 2017 to 2018.

FOR 50 YEARS, RIVEREDGE STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS HAVE WORKED TO MAINTAIN THE BOUNTIFUL WOODLANDS, WETLANDS, AND PRAIRIES THAT CURRENTLY COMPRISE THE NATURAL SANCTUARY.

From hand-pulling invasive species to multi-year research projects, Riveredge has always been, and continues to be, at the forefront in land restoration and preservation. 2017 marked the 13th year of the Return the Sturgeon Reintroduction Project, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS), and the 12th year of the Sturgeon Fest celebration. During this time, the project has introduced over 15,000 young fish with a survival rate over 95% to re-establish a breeding population of Lake Sturgeon to the Milwaukee River.





Native Orchid

RESTORATION PROJECT

In summer 2018, Riveredge began a native orchid restoration project, in partnership with the Smithsonian's Orchid Conservation Center, Chicago Botanic Gardens, Stantec, Sheboygan County, and other organizations. For several years, Riveredge will be used as a germination spot for rare, native orchid species to be transplanted regionally and nationally.

THROUGH PROGRAMS, PARTNERSHIPS, LAND STEWARDSHIP, AND RESEARCH PROJECTS, RIVEREDGE IS SUSTAINING THE LEGACY OF THOSE WHO CAME BEFORE US AND WILL STRIVE TO LEAD THE WAY IN ECOLOGICAL RESTORATION AND EDUCATION FOR THE NEXT 50 YEARS.


ENDOWMENT STATEMENT

Riveredge Nature Center holds three designated endowment funds: the Jane B. Pettit Fund, Andy Larsen Legacy Fund, and East Property Endowment Fund. As of June 30, 2018, these funds had an approximate combined market value of \$2,900,871. Riveredge has drawn 5% of the combined average market value of the three endowment funds on December 3I of the past three years to cover endowment-designated expenses.

The Center also holds unrestricted investment funds. As of June 30, 2018, these funds had an approximate combined market value of \$1,978,629. Riveredge has drawn 5% of the combined average market value of these funds on December 3I of the past three years to partially cover operating expense for the Center. Additional withdrawals are made from the unrestricted funds to support capital projects and special projects/initiatives. The Riveredge Nature Center Board of Directors approves all uses of these funds.






Yet in the areas where we could put our learning and teaching into practice—schoolyards, churches, hospitals, roadsides, and most obvious of all, our own yards—we neaten and bleaken, consistently and relentlessly destroying habitat for almost all life.

We must have places where soil is made, and materials and organisms to make it. We must have scavengers. We must have predators. We should know that some prairie plants should have holes in their leaves from feasting larvae which become butterflies and that they then pollinate the flowers so that seeds can form, from which

we get more plants for us to eat or for animals







THE BEGINNING

1965 - **IT STARTS WITH A DREAM** by the Whitefish Bay Garden Club and its president, Isabel Lillie, of a place where a slice of wild Wisconsin could be protected, nurtured, and used as an incredible learning laboratory for so many in southeast Wisconsin.

1968 - **THE FIRST 72 ACRES** that would become Riveredge is purchased along the Milwaukee River from Dr. E. P. Grady, a dentist in Kewaunee.


1968 - THE "RIVEREDGE FOUNDATION, INC." is recognized as a nonprofit entity on January 16, 1968.

1969 - ANDY LARSEN IS HIRED as the Center's chief naturalist, and he immediately begins developing the Riveredge style of inquiry-based education and research-based restoration efforts.

1969 - THE FIRST CHRISTMAS BIRD COUNT is held.

1970 - THE FIRST CLASS OF TEACHING NATURALISTS GRADUATES. Armed with passion and lessons on the interconnectedness of life from Andy, they set the bar high for educators to come. The first class included Kathy Bourne, Donna Hodgson, Hildy Libherr, Sylvia Miller, Laurie Otto, Hattie Purtell, Mary Simpson (Kohler), Libby Smith, and Betty Winter.

1970 - BIRD BANDING BEGINS at Riveredge.

IN THE BEGINNING, ON A SPRING MORNING

IN 1965, it was Mary Berry who called me to say she'd support a suggestion I'd made to the Whitefish Bay Garden Club—it was to start a school forest for Whitefish Bay children. Mary's enthusiasm was inspiring—it persuaded me that ultimately other club members might become interested in the project. And many did.

Of course, after Donna Hodgson volunteered to help, she became an invaluable colleague in the early organizational stage when it was a bit of a struggle to keep the ball rolling. She and I planned together, she persuaded many of her wonderful friends to join us—including Char Johnson and Roger Boerner and HIS friend, Jim Grootemaat...Donna opened her home for every meeting—she was a great contributor in every way.

There was Paul Olson, president of the Nature Conservancy, who came from Madison to help build interest for the project in Whitefish Bay, where we held a community meeting at the high school. He was a great speaker and won us many friends.

And I'll never forget the counsel Roger Boerner gave Donna and me. It was to "think big"—to plan for a facility that could serve the other communities of metropolitan Milwaukee as well as Whitefish Bay. Roger also named Riveredge, by the way, and we decided to keep it all one word to make it easier for donors to write checks.

There was my very dear friend, Marge Reisinger, who first learned about the availability of the 72 acres of riverfront land which formed the original Riveredge acquisition. Marge, who died some years ago, was one of our first board members and a dedicated environmentalist when most people had never heard the term. She invited scientists she knew around the state to inspect the riverfront property and determine its suitability for a nature center.

Although many individuals we contacted in the early days thought Riveredge was an impossible idea, there were a number of organizations and institutions that encouraged or supported us right from the start. Most memorable are the Whitefish Bay School System, the Wauwatosa School System, The Whitefish Bay Woman's Club, the Milwaukee Journal and the Nature Conservancy. Most important, of course, was the Whitefish Bay Garden Club, the group that started it all. And crucial to our success was the incredibly timely grant we received—through the efforts of many dedicated people—from the Junior League of Milwaukee, thus making it possible to us to hire a full-time naturalist [Andy Larsen]."

1970 --- 1980

1971 & 1972 - THE HANLEY AND WALLNER PROPERTIES are added to the natural sanctuary, increasing its size by an additional 142 acres.

1975 - ON FEBRUARY 24TH, a fire destroys the only building at Riveredge. Andy Larsen reported, "It served as a classroom, maintenance center, field and research office, teacher-naturalist lunchroom, auditorium, and educational equipment storage building. The loss of this facility and its contents is a disappointment, but as my seven-year-old daughter said, 'I'm glad it wasn't the fields and forests."

1975 - THE TRAGEDY OF THE FIRE leads to the realization of a dream. A 10-acre parcel of the Sugarline Farm was offered for sale by the owners. This land included a 100-year-old farmhouse and the "Barn," "Coop," and "Farm Pond" still used today. The first prairie restoration begins at Riveredge.

1978 - A WINTER ADVENTURE at Judy and Andy Larsen's Bayfield cabin kicks off more than a decade of Riveredge Ed-Venture trips throughout the world led by Barbara Gilmore. From Yellowstone to Kenya, participants learned hands-on about ecology and culture.

1978 - 8.65 ACRES IS ADDED directly west of the Farm House and includes the Riveredge Creek. This land was home to a short-lived, low-ropes course at Riveredge and is known as "Together Trek Woods" to many.

1980 - THE 19.5-ACRE "HAWK WOODS" becomes a part of Riveredge.



Preparing people to make educated choices about the social, political, and economic activities that affect the environment that maintains their lives must be a major purpose of education.



1980 ---- 1990

1980 - THE FIRST YULE LOG CELEBRATION takes place.

1982 - ANDY LARSEN WRITES: "Change is the only constant. Nothing ever remains the same. Everything is becoming something else."

1985 - THE 51-ACRE "MAYHEW WOODS" property becomes a part of Riveredge, reflecting the Center's awareness of the necessity of size as a component of species preservation.

1985-86 - THE DESIGNATION OF THE RIVEREDGE CREEK as a State Natural Area and, subsequently, the Milwaukee River as a priority watershed, leads Riveredge to focus attention on its role as a steward of waterways, an emphasis that continues today.

1986 - RIVEREDGE BIRD CLUB BEGINS, founded by Noel J. Cutright and other dedicated bird enthusiasts. Today, the club has been renamed in honor of its founder.

1990 - TESTING THE WATERS, a program bringing together schools, nature centers, and public agencies, launches with the goal of training local students in water-quality evaluation, allowing them to become connected with and invested in the health of their local waters. Riveredge took a leadership role in this program that continues today with a recent expansion.

THEWISIT THE CORE OF THE BUILDING IS THE OCTAGONAL VISITOR CENTER, which reflects Ozaukee County's unique "Clausling Barn" architecture. This large space houses the visitor reception and sales areas, and provides an interpretive display area. Additional features limit the impact, or "footprint," the building has on the Earth. Those features include a **GEOTHERMAL** HEATING SYSTEM, SOLAR POWER, AND OUR UNIQUE ENGINEERED WETLAND WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM.



1988-90 - CONCERN ABOUT RIVEREDGE'S ABILITY TO RESPOND TO GROWING DEMANDS

for its services leads to the launch of a \$3.35 million capital campaign for construction of a new environmental education center and endowment. In June 1989, ground is broken for the new (and current) Visitor Center building. Staff and volunteers move into the building in May 1990. As relayed by Riveredge leadership: "Two experiences highlight the importance of this new facility to our programs. The first occurred just two weeks after moving into the building when a cold, driving rain welcomed attendees at Eco Focus 9. For the first time in 13 years, the weather was so bad that we were driven indoors. Fortunately, there was an indoors into which to retreat and the workshops continued. The second highlight occurred while observing a class of students, each at their own microscopes, in the new classroom. Listening to them as they ooohed and ahhhhed over what they had collected in the pond reinforced the conviction that our efforts have been most worthwhile."

1991 - DESIGNED BY THE FIRM OF PLUNKETT KEYMAR REGINATO ARCHITECTS, the new

Center building is awarded the "Design Honor Award" by the Wisconsin Society of Architects.

1990 - - - - - - 2000 - - - -

1992 - GREENLER INSECT STUDY BEGINS. Led by longtime Habitat Healer Barbara Greenler, volunteers work for 11 years to gather, identify, and record more than 1,700 specimens of insects from specific prairie plants at Riveredge. The purpose of this study was to determine if relationships between specific insects and prairie plants existed, as well as to foster citizen science involvement.

1993 - LOOKING FOR A NEW WAY TO RAISE FUNDS, volunteer organizers Mary LaVelle, Kine Torinus, and Susie Kasten launch the River Valley Bike Ride, starting a summer tradition still going strong and beloved by cyclists throughout the region for over 25 years.

1995 - RIVEREDGE GOES INTERNATIONAL! Partnering with the Milwaukee Public Museum, funds are raised to purchase and protect a 750-acre tract of rare Costa Rican rain forest and build an educational center there called the Tirimbina Rainforest Center. These efforts allowed visitors to observe the connections in nature between Wisconsin and Costa Rica and expanded both organizations' missions of education, research, and conservation.

1998 - WORKING WITH A LOCAL **ENGINEER, DAVE FLOWERS, Riveredge** installs the first engineered wetland wastewater treatment system in Wisconsin. This constructed sedge meadow allows all of Riveredge's wastewater to be cleaned as it flows through a series of wetland plants.

1999 - BEGIN WITH A SEED, A RIVEREDGE GUIDE TO GROWING WISCONSIN PRAIRIE PLANTS, IS PUBLISHED. Compiled by Al Heon and based on the deep well of knowledge of Andy Larsen and the Riveredge Habitat Healers, this publication is still used today to establish native prairies throughout the region.

2005-2007 - SUSTAINABLE FOOD BECOMES A FOCUS OF RIVEREDGE **PROGRAMMING** with a Children's Organic Garden designed in 2005. The 2006 purchase of the 19.2-acre "Wallner Farm" expands the program and transforms a wornout, 4-acre cornfield into a permaculture demonstration site called "Woodland Harvest" in 2007. Children and adults alike utilize these spaces and their fruits (literally!) to learn about food production and growing in harmony with the natural world.

2006-2007 - IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE WISCONSIN DNR, Riveredge launches a 25-year project to bring back Lake Sturgeon to spawn in the Milwaukee River, where not a single sturgeon had been seen since the 1890's! With day-to-day operations handled almost entirely by volunteers, the project is a prime example of citizen science and restoration. Sturgeon Fest, a community celebration of the release of each year's young sturgeon, begins in 2007.

2008 - EMERALD ASH BORER IS DISCOVERED A QUARTER MILE FROM RIVEREDGE. Over the next decade, this invasive insect will kill almost all of the ash trees on the property. Seeing opportunity in a dire situation, Riveredge partners with university research projects to test experimental management techniques and hosts public educational events about the management of ash trees and onsite processing of wood from dying trees.

2009 - "LARSEN ROCKS" IS DEDICATED ON NOVEMBER 7.

This rock assemblage was installed in honor of Andy Larsen as a fun, creative space where kids of all ages can explore, climb, hide, or just sit and reflect.

2010 - THE 8.9 ACRES NORTH OF HAWK WOODS, now known as "Ernie's Woods," becomes a part of Riveredge and maple sugaring continues on this tract once owned by volunteer Ernie Pochert, also known during maple sugar season as "Father Fire."

2012 - THE NATURAL PLAY AREA AT RIVEREDGE IS OPENED!

Including tree houses, a babbling stream, a silo cavern, and plenty of frog ponds, this "muddy hands" area becomes the antidote to plastic playground equipment for all Riveredge Kids.

2013 - AS PART OF THE 45TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS, the "Farm Dinner" and "Frothy Forage" events make their debut at Riveredge.

2013 - STURGEON FEST MOVES TO LAKESHORE STATE PARK IN

MILWAUKEE, engaging urban audiences to learn about and interact with this species native to the Great Lakes and surrounding rivers. Riveredge's annual Student Research Symposium "Connections in Nature" begins.

2014 - RECREATIONAL TREE CLIMBING, using arborist equipment, is launched at Riveredge and takes 500 climbers of all ages into the trees during its first season.

2014 - RIVEREDGE CREATES THE SCIENTIST IN RESIDENCE

PROGRAM with the West Bend School District and expands into the Cedarburg School District the next year, placing a fully funded environmental educator directly in the schools to inspire outdoor learning.

2016 - A NATURE-BASED 4K PROGRAM IS LAUNCHED in partnership with the West Bend School District and the Kettle Moraine YMCA, where students spend 70% of their time engaged in nature-based learning activities.

2017 - THE COMMUNITY RIVERS PROGRAM IS LAUNCHED in the

village of Newburg and expands to the villages of Saukville and Grafton the next year. This first-of-its-kind collaboration in the upper Milwaukee River watershed brings together residents, municipal leaders, and watershed groups to provide hands-on experiences like kayaking and fishing that aim to inspire personal connections to the river, as well as resources on how to make positive land management changes that, when combined, collectively improve the health of the river.

From the tens of thousands of students who awakened a curiosity and passion for the natural world during an unforgettable field trip to Riveredge to a slew of partnerships with local school districts aimed at making the health, happiness, and academic benefits of learning outside an option for all kids, inquiry-based outdoor learning has been at the core of Riveredge's identity and mission. That's why Riveredge is developing the first nature-based public charter school in southeast Wisconsin in partnership with the Northern Ozaukee School District. Riveredge applied on behalf of the future school and was awarded a Charter School Planning & Implementation


Grant from the DPI in June 2018. Launching in the 2019-2020 school year, the "Riveredge Outdoor Learning Elementary School" will ultimately invite 99 K-5 learners to spend their school year exploring, discovering, and learning in the 379-acre Riveredge classroom. The school's mission is "To serve as a laboratory for outdoor learning which amplifies the outcomes of public education, serves learners of all abilities and needs, fosters a deep connection to the environment, and prepares students for success in school and life."

A SWEET STORY Continues...

For 50 years, maple sugarin' has been not just a program at Riveredge, but a way of life. Perhaps nothing better exemplifies the mix of whimsy, fun, learning, community, and natural wonder that makes Riveredge, well, Riveredge, than the connection of enjoying a sweet, maple sugar-soaked pancake right after helping tap trees for sap. This sense of wonder comes to us thanks to hundreds of people who, for five decades in early spring, have devoted themselves to making it all happen; including folks with interesting names like The Big Sap, Father Fire, Picklepuss, Sap Queen, and Maple Madman.

And now this year, longtime Riveredge supporters Mal, Jill, and Jamie Hepburn (Jamie being a Riveredge Kid himself) have teamed up with the Hepburn "Bootstrap" Foundation and Ozaukee Bank's Gift to the Future Fund to make a coordinated gift to Riveredge. This gift will fund 100% of the cost to construct a new, but still rustic, lodge-style Sugarbush House.

This incredible facility will allow the expansion of not only our maple sugarin' programs enjoyed by thousands of students and community members each year, but also will be used as a year-round classroom space expanding capacity to meet the needs of Riveredge's growing educational programs. The Sugarbush House is planned to be open for the 2019 Sugarin' celebrations!





RIVEREDGE IS RECOGNIZED AS A LEADER IN WATER-BASED EDUCATION THAT INSTILLS CITIZEN RESPONSIBILITY ACROSS GENERATIONS.

Historical highlights include coordinating the Testing the Waters (TTW) program which trains high school students throughout the Greater Milwaukee area in water-quality monitoring. We partner with Milwaukee Riverkeeper to recruit and train citizen water-quality monitors in the Water Action Volunteers (WAV) program, and offer high-quality watershed education programs to thousands of students throughout the Greater Milwaukee Area.

As a result, Riveredge is uniquely qualified to lead long-term community initiatives focused on the health of our watershed. As we plan for the future, look for an intentional effort to bring Riveredge back to the river—where it all began with a dream and a 72-acre purchase 50 years ago!
